



Spanish Red Wine Trophy for Mirto 2005 at the International Wine Challenge 2008

The annual gala IWC Awards dinner, that was held at the Grosvenor House in London last September 3rd, revealed the champions of the 2008, and where Mirto 2005 by Ramón Bilbao received a national Trophy in the Spanish Red Wine category on an evening that is generally accepted as the Oscars of the wine trade.

Of the wines awarded gold medals a few wines have been elevated from gold medal to trophy status following a further rigorous blind tasting.

The international wine Challenge is the largest wine competition in the world and is managed by the prestigious Wine Magazine owned by William Reed Company
